Bus Trips

The Barrhill CIC is continuing to fund monthly bus trips for the residents of Barrhill. Posters are up with planned trips, but all suggestions of trips are welcome to Celia Strain or to any of the directors.

Barrhill CIC Logo

The new logo for the CIC has now been agreed and all future correspondence, membership and funding application forms and meeting notifications will be using this logo. A mock up of the logo is shown above which is being developed as a high quality image for future documents.

Speed Sign for Barrhill

Following local concerns over speeding traffic, Barrhill CIC has agreed to fund a new speed sign for Barrhill which will be located in the same place as the previous sign. This was a temporary sign put in by South Ayrshire Council. The sign will go up shortly. The cost for this sign is around £4,000 but as it is solar powered, will not have any energy costs and comes with a 6 year maintenance warranty.

Barrhill Toilets

Barrhill Toilets are now owned and administered by the Barrhill Memorial Hall Community Association (BMHCA), with responsibility for maintenance and the cleaning contract passed over to the committee. The cleaning contract is funded by the BCIC.

Car Park

Paths

Access agreements for Martyrs' Tomb walk and Lennie Wood are going forward which will enable the BCIC to engage a contractor to keep the paths strimmed and in good order.

Children of Barrhill and district (aged 8 – 18) can take up a free activity day at Loch Ken on Wednesday 10th April. Staff at Loch Ken will supervise the children. If any parents are prepared to accompany their children on the Barrhill Bus, then this can be booked; otherwise parents make their own transport arrangements.
